### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

#### LOGISTICS

The planning process will begin during lunch on A.O.P. day 5. At lunch A.O.P. leadership teams will begin to identify prodedures for implementing a program design process. A significant portion of the afternoon will be given to program design and consultation arrangements. Program will be implemented until 11:30 am A.O.P. day 6. At this time the A.O.P. class will begin to evaluate program and process the experience.

### PROGRAM CRITERIA

The following criteria will be used to guide program development.

- 1. A program design process which addresses needs assessment through to program evaluation will be utilized.
- 2. Consideration will be given to the value and nature of adventure, specifically the ten values and fourteen characteristics identified in class. PLEASE RE-AQUAINT YOURSELF!
- 3. Programs will be conducted with the highest consideration for safety and environmentally sound practice.
- 4. Consultants will be used to assist with aspects of the program which require specific technical skills.
- 5. Written program plans will be approved by the President of T.A.C.I. Program route cards will remain at the T.A.C.I. office.
  - 6. Consulation by appointment only.
- 7. Leaders are responsible for the care, maintenence, and 'clean' return of all equipment.
- 8. Overnight locations will be considered in conjunction with program design.
